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The purpose of this study is to find out what effects (good or bad) CASAD has on preventing diarrhea from developing during chemotherapy. CASAD is a naturally occurring clay-like compound that is approved as a food additive that had been studied in persons with diarrhea related to infection. In this study, CASAD will be compared to a placebo (medication that is similar in size, color and shape to the study drug but had no effect).
